The cover of each special edition of Angling Times columnist Dom Garnett's acclaimed book, *Crooked Lines*, has been handcrafted from real fish skin.

In collaboration with Devon artist Kari Furre, these initial works of art have been fashioned from natural and dyed Icelandic salmon skin - later versions will use cod and wolf fish.

A painstaking combination of tools and processes is used, from centuries-old curing methods to modern bookbinding techniques, and all the fish skins come from
